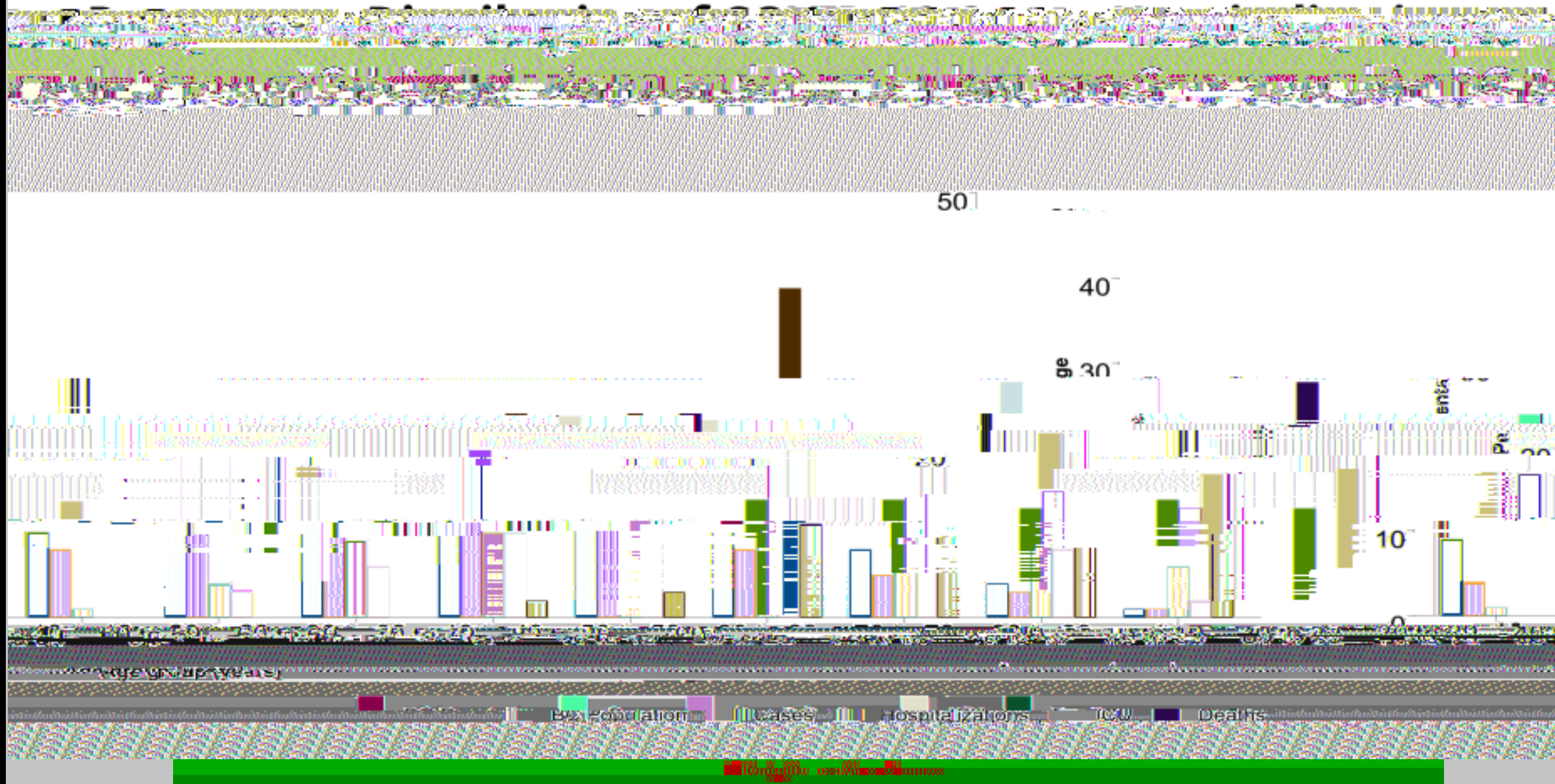
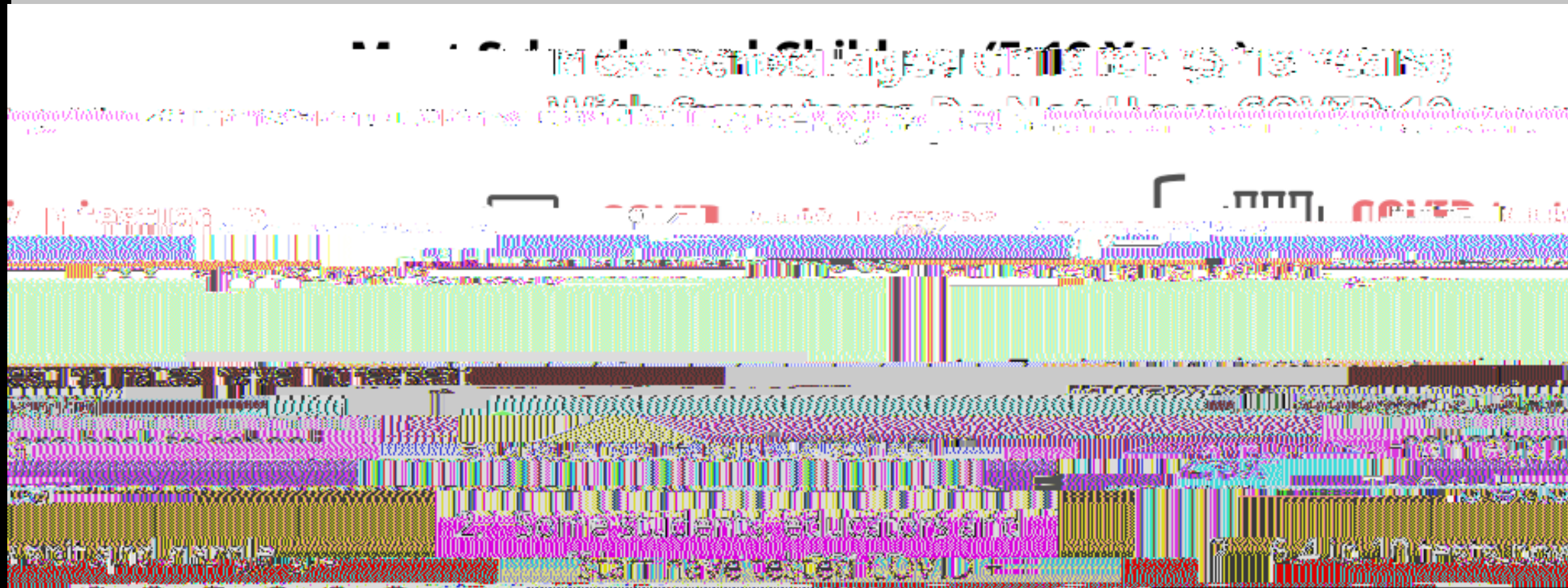

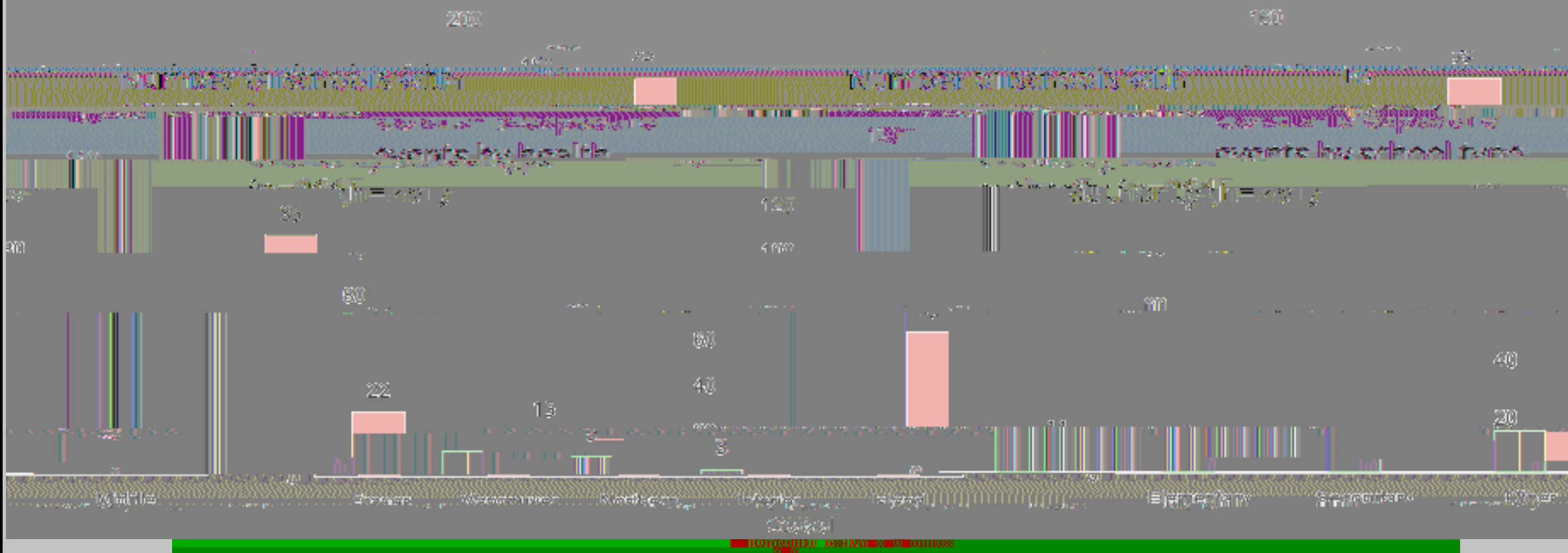




COVID-19 in British Columbia

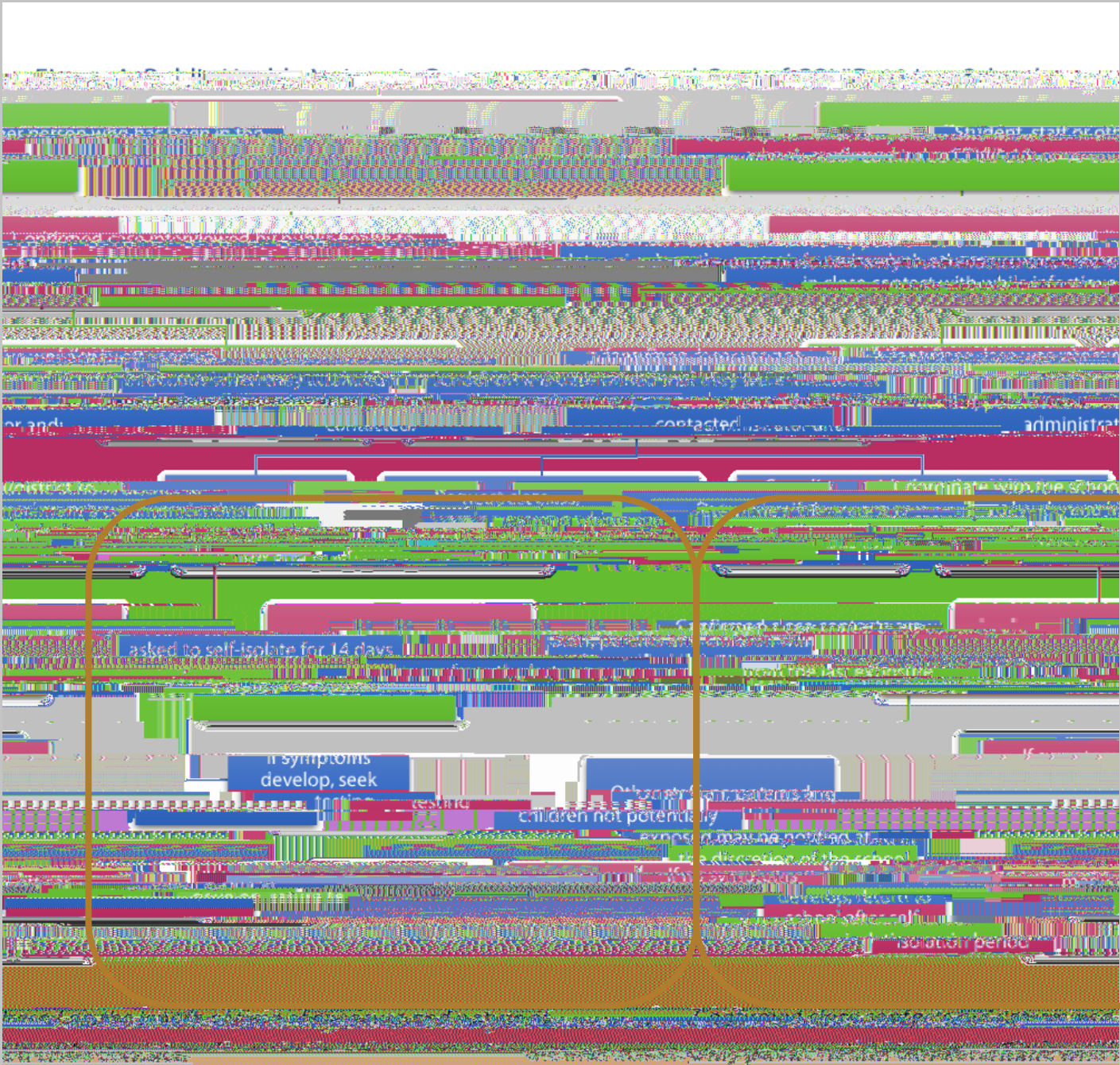
